



WICC MASJID ETIQUETTE



1. Honor and revere it. Allah says, “And whoever honors the symbols of Allah – indeed, it is from the piety of hearts.” (22:32)
2. You are Allah’s guest, so act in the best way. It is stated in a Prophetic narration that, “[The one who goes to the masjid] is the guest of Allah.” (Tabarani) Where else can you be a guest of Allah?!
3. Leave your house with Wudu
4. Park your car properly in appropriate spaces. Do not block others from entering or leaving.
5. Dress properly and respectfully
6. Enter the Masjid with the right foot, praying the Masnoon Dua and leave the Masjid with the left foot, praying the Masnoon Dua
7. Do not indulge in worldly conversations
8. Do not engage in any worldly activities (buying, selling, etc.)
9. If you have eaten something with a bad odor, thoroughly clean the mouth out before entering the Masjid
10. Spend time in the Masjid praying Salah, Reading Qur’an, Praying Tasbeeh, listening to Khutbah and learning Islamic Knowledge.
11. It is NOT permissible to remove any of the Masjid’s items for personal use
12. Do not run, play or mess about in the Masjid. It is the House of Allah, Respect It!
13. Switch off all cell phones.
14. If you bring your children to the Masjid, please make sure that they are with you and supervised at all times and that they are at the Masjid to worship Allah SWT and not play in parking lots, or run around disturbing others worship.
15. Patience is a gift from Allah SWT as stated in the Qur’an. Please pray to Allah to grant us that Patience or Sabr and help us practice our Deen at all times.

The mosques of Allah shall be visited and maintained by such as believe in Allah and the Last Day, establish regular prayers, and practice regular charity, and fear none (at all) except Allah. It is they who are expected to be on true guidance. (Surah At-Tawba, 18)
